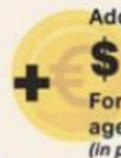

CONTINUED SUPPORT FOR WORKERS AND JOBS

Preserving Core Capabilities



- Further support for hardest-hit sectors such as **aerospace, aviation, and tourism** to retain **core capabilities**



- **\$187 million** to extend support measures in the **Enhanced Aviation Support Package** up to March 2021
 - **Cost relief** for our airlines, ground handlers, cargo agents, and airport tenants
 - Support local carriers to **regain Singapore's air connectivity** to the world
- **Temporary redeployment programme scaled up** for workers in the aviation sector



- **\$320 million** to boost domestic tourism through **tourism credits (SingapoRediscoveries Vouchers)**

Transforming Our Economy For A Post-COVID-19 World



- Set aside **up to \$150 million**, to enhance the **Startup SG Founder programme** in phases
 - Raise the startup capital grant
 - Continue to provide mentorship

Jobs Support Scheme

- Support for wages **extended up to March 2021**
- **Up to 50% support**, based on projected recovery of the different sectors

Creating Job Opportunities



Jobs Growth Incentive

- **\$1 billion** programme to support firms to increase their headcount of local workers over the next six months
- For each new local hire, Government will provide wage subsidy for 12 months
 - **Up to 25%** for those below 40 years old, subject to cap
 - **Up to 50%** for those aged 40 and above, subject to cap

COVID-19 Support Grant

- Application period **extended** up to **December 2020**
- Open to both existing CSG recipients and new applicants from 1 October 2020
- Unemployed applicants must demonstrate job search or training efforts to qualify

Workfare Special Payment

- **Eligibility widened** to those who received Workfare Income Supplement for work done in 2020, and who are not already receiving the Special Payment
- One-off payment of **\$3,000** to be received from October 2020 onwards

JOBS SUPPORT SCHEME

Saving Jobs, Protecting Livelihoods

The JSS payouts benefit over 2 million local workers employed in more than 150,000 firms

- 1 Extended support for wages up to **Mar 2021**, from the current Aug 2020
- 2 Adjusted support based on projected recovery of the different sectors
